

## GUIDE

### 1. Install

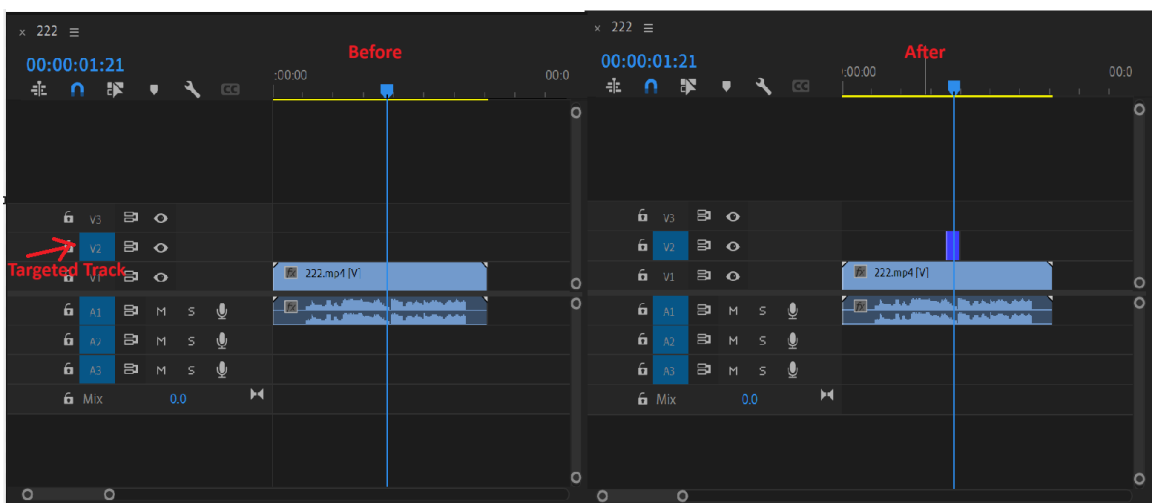
- Download the zipped installer file
- Extract the zip file
- Run the installer
  - On Windows: Open the .exe file and follow the setup wizard
  - On Mac: Open the .pkg file and follow the setup wizard
- Complete installation and restart the adobe Premiere Pro.
- Find FastFX in Extension Menu of Premiere Pro

### 2. Manual

-How to apply “Hits/Flashes/Wipes” effect

This effect is applied on the targeted video track at the timeline playhead

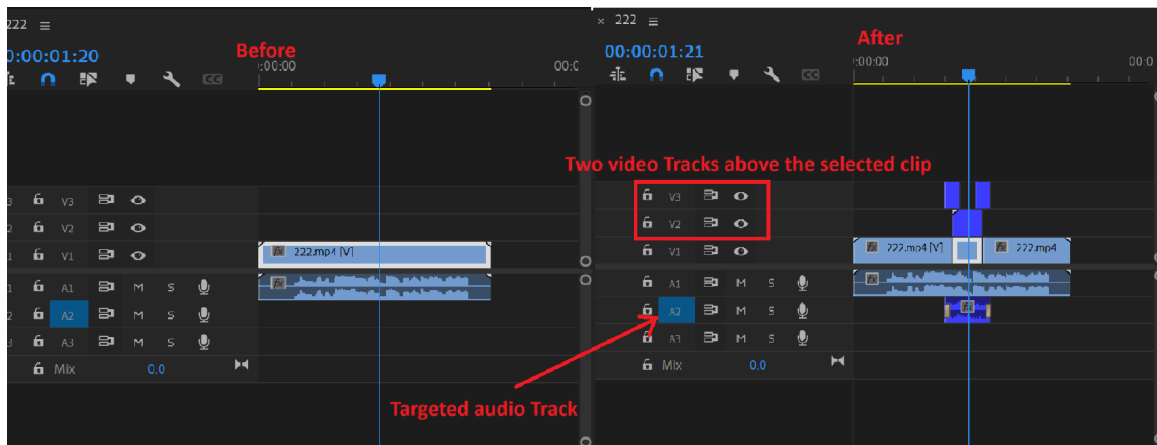
If the targeted video track has already clip at the timeline playhead, the effect can't be applied



So the user needs to find the position that the effect can be added and then should apply the effect into the right position.

-How to apply “Transitions” effect

This effect is applied on the two video tracks above the selected clip and the targeted audio track.



The user needs to find the right timeline position that the effect can be added in two video tracks and audio track.

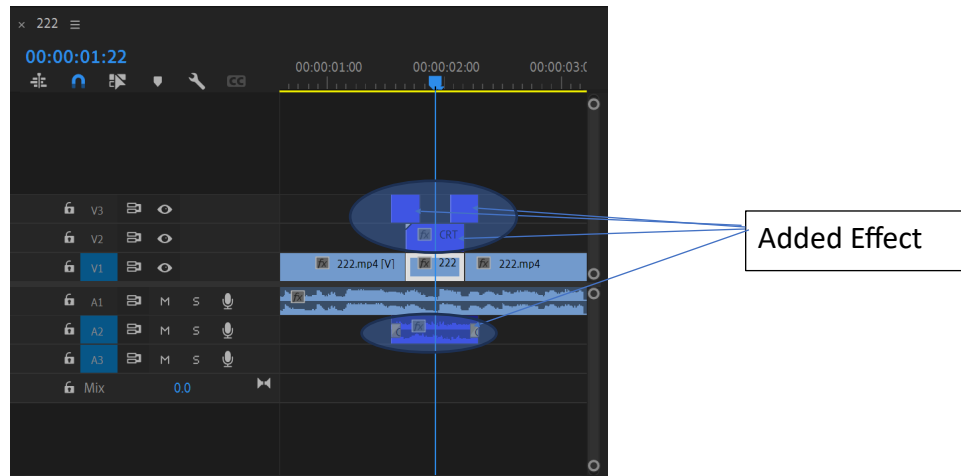
### 3. Issue

#### 1) 406 issue

Title: Clash with existing clips

Text: Please target another video video track or move CTI

-Transitions



As you can see, if you add Transition effect into the middle clip of v1 track, you should make empty space ( Like Ellipse into the above picture) that the effect can be added into V2, V3 track and A3 track.

The transitions effect is added the two above video tracks and targeted audio track.

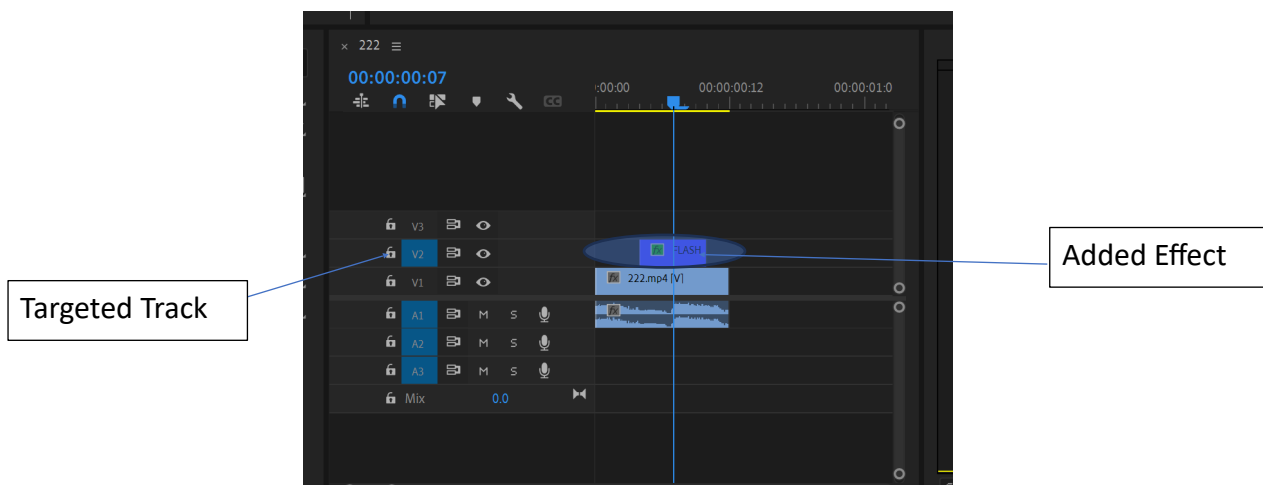
So you need to make empty space to add them.

But if the empty space doesn't exists, 406 issue happens.

In this case you should make empty space on v2 and v3 track by shifting or deleting clips that they put in the space to be added for Effect.

-Hits,Flashes,Wipes

You should make empty space into the targeted video track



## 2) 410 issue

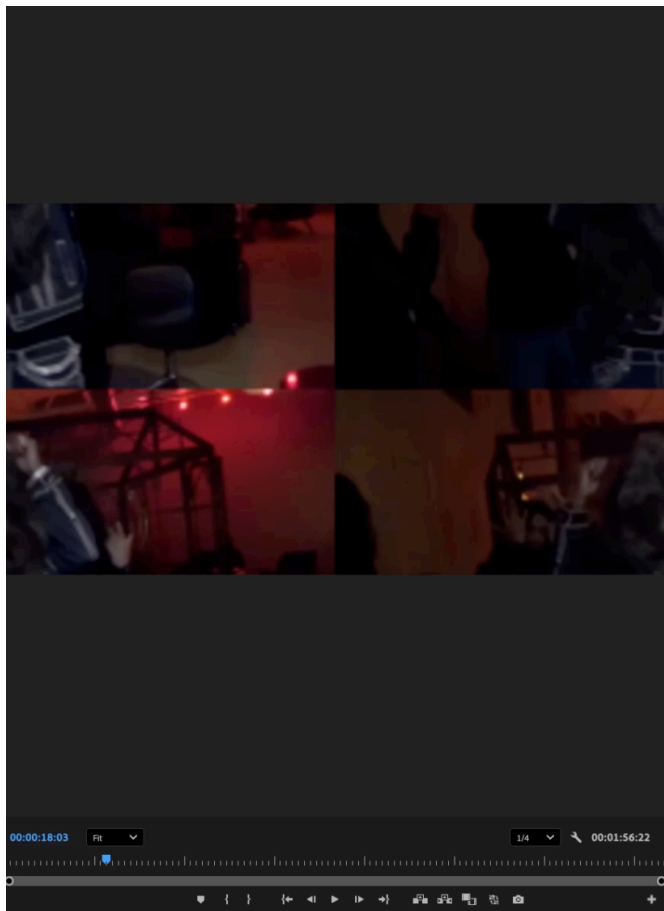
Title: No clips found at CTI

Text: Please ensure there are clips on the timeline

This issue happens when the sequence has fps like 100 from imported video.

Adobe Premiere API doesn't support such fps so you need to change robust fps like 24 fps.

If you are noticing this 4 box effect on some hits here is how you solve it:



some of the hits will show up in boxes of 4 if the users playback is set to 1/4 or 1/2 it should be at full to not get this error but it wont apply when rendering if you have to use 1/4 because of a slow PC. also don't change the resolution when rendering, have it be the same as the sequence or this error will happen
